SCCA Milwaukee Region Rallye Group

Our road rallye schedule for this year will include 5 time-speed-distance (TSD) events. Each of these road rallyes will offer a slightly different experience, and all of them can be run by people with little or no road rallye experience.

Oktoberally - Saturday, September 19th

Badger Trails - Sunday, September 20th

Start and finish at the Settle Inn in La Crosse, Wisconsin. These rallyes are put on by the Land O' Lakes Region of SCCA and the Sports Car Club of La Crosse. The rallyes are offered in two different versions - either as a National rally or as a Regional rally. Both events are approximately 180 miles long.

The National version of **Oktoberally** on Saturday is a rather difficult course rallye with traps on most legs (sometimes multiple traps on a leg). Folks who have only run a couple of rallyes in their lifetime would find the National version of this event very difficult.

Oktoberally is also offered as a Regional rallye with the same route but with much simpler route instructions. It will operate as what is known as a Monte Carlo rallye where you will be told the correct time to arrive at each control. You just follow the route instructions and then try to cross the checkpoint line at exactly the time they have told you. When you register, you just choose whether you want the National version or the Regional version.

Badger Trails on Sunday is a tour rallye with no traps. It also is offered in both a National and a Regional version, with the Regional version being designed for people with less rallye experience.

Both rallyes use only paved roads. Both rallyes will be very professionally done and both have won the coveted SCCA Gervais award for Rallye of the Year multiple times. See [flyer](#) for registration for both rallyes
