June 12th at State Fair Park - The Milwaukee Mile

The Great Lakes Sports Car Club and Hall Mazda have invited the Badgerland Miata Club to join them for a Sunday at the track.

We have been invited to park as a group to spend Sunday the 12th, in the infield, with the drivers and watch the day's events including races in the afternoon.

Here is how the day is planned.

We're going to start our day with breakfast somewhere near State Fair park. The location will depend on the number of you that join us.

- If you choose not to join us for breakfast the practice and qualifying sessions start at 9:00 AM and you can arrive any time after that.
- Admission to the event is free, but parking is now \$6.00 at the Fair Park, so be prepared.
- Enter on 84th street, just south of the Pettit Center and head straight ahead to Grandstand Avenue in the park. *(Remember there is no East bound exit off I-94, use Greenfield Ave if necessary.)*
- At the north end of the grandstand, go to the entrance of the tunnel to get your wrist band. Then you can head to the infield and join our club. If we can get enough folks attending, we'll set up our own paddock.
- We will have full access to the infield, which includes the cars, the drivers and crews, so please be mindful of their cars and equipment. We are guests and they are at work, as it were.
- There will be a catering vendor in the pits at lunch for drivers and crews, guests. However with your wrist band you will be able to leave the grounds and return should you so please.
- After lunch there will be 5 races, starting at about 1:00 PM. At least 2 of which will be heavy with Miatas, and the spec Miata race will be at about 1:45.
- Racing will continue to about 5:30.
- After that you're on your own, although we might end up someplace to discuss the day's events.
